Objective
JESUS AND THE CHILDREN: Jesus Wants Us to Come to Him.
"Let the little children come to me." Mark 10:14

Opening
Introduce the song "Little Children"
Introduce and sing the memory verse, Mark 10:14

Whole Group
READ: Jesus and the Children in The Beginner's Bible.
DISCUSS: The disciples thought Jesus was too busy for the children, but Jesus the children to know they were important to Him and that God's kingdom was too. Talk about how we are never too little to come to Jesus. We can come to Him if we are happy, sad, scared, thankful, or need help.
ACTIVITY: Place a picture of Jesus in the center and have learners stand around Him. Say, "When I'm scared, I can come to Jesus," and have learners take a step toward Jesus. Continue with examples such as being sad, needing help, making a mistake, or wanting to say thank you. Continue until everyone has gathered around Jesus.

Learning Resources
SONG BOOK: Sing "Jesus and the Children" song to retell the story.
COME AND SEE JESUS: Read Come and See Jesus. Talk about how Jesus made time for the children and wanted them to come near Him. Remind learners that Jesus was always there for them, and we can come to Him anytime by talking to Him in prayer.

Small Groups/Center
COME TO JESUS: Model how we can come to Jesus by in prayer. Give learners examples of how we can come to Jesus: like feeling scared, being thankful, or needing help, and practice what they can pray.

Craft
COME TO JESUS HEADBAND: Learners create a headband to remember that Jesus welcomes children and wants us to come to Him.
LET THE CHILDREN COME: Learners create an pull apart craft to show how the disciples tried to keep the children away, but Jesus welcomed them.

Independent
MEMORY VERSE: Have the learners trace and color the memory verse and glue the bracelet around their wrist.
COLORING PAGE: Have the learners color the page.

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Whole Group

READ: Jesus and the Children in The Beginner's Bible.

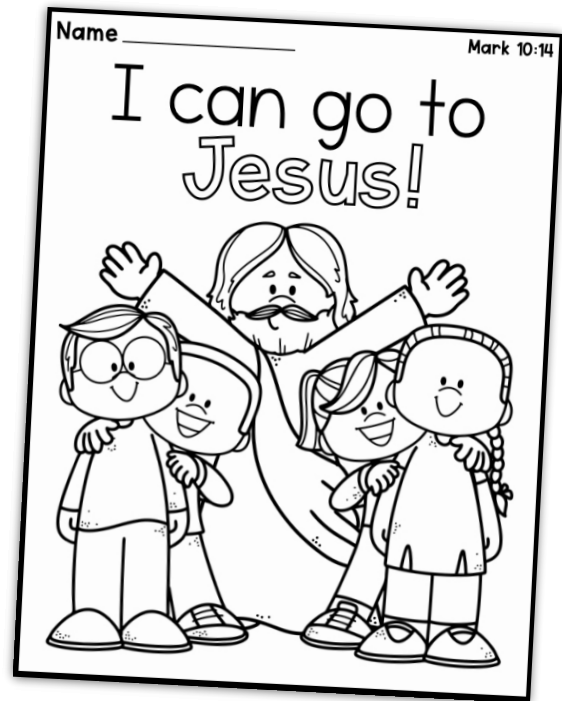

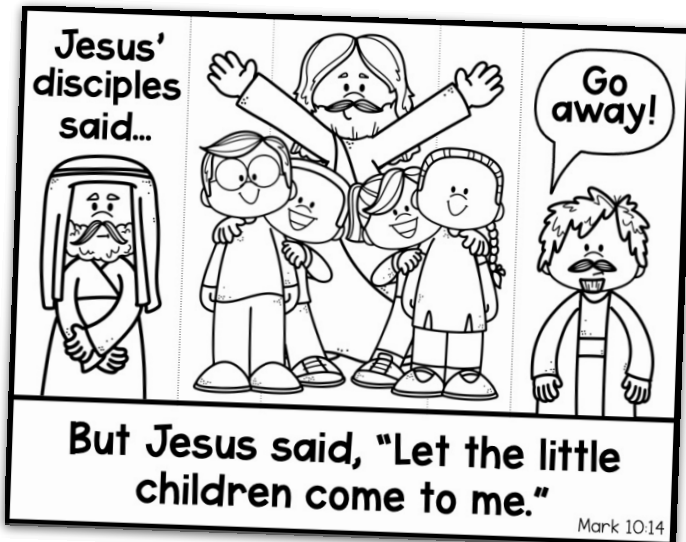
